

INTERNS & WORK EXPERIENCE FAQ

Q: How can I get Work Experience at Puppet Place?

A: The simple answer is probably not. Our Resident Artists are all freelance, self-employed or are part of small companies, and as such they are often on tour or work irregular and unsociable hours which means committing to provide Work Experience months in advance is just not possible as they won't know what their schedule will be like this far in ahead.

Our advice is to do your research thoroughly by checking out our [**Resident Artists**](#) and our [**Associate Artists**](#) and approach the bigger companies listed directly to see if they are able to offer you Work Experience, and be as flexible with the timing as you possibly can.

Q: How can I get an Internship at Puppet Place?

A: Internships are only available when one of our Resident or Associate Artists is working on a bigger project, for example a Stop-Motion Animation Film or Theatre Production or Festival, where they have the capacity and budget to take on an Intern. Again do your research thoroughly by checking out our [**Resident Artists**](#) and our [**Associate Artists**](#). Follow the ones you think are the best match for you on Social Media so that you can get a feel for the sorts of productions they work on and approach them directly to see if they have any projects coming up where they might need an intern.
